Duties

- Support the Unit's effort in collecting and interpreting data relating to the indicators identified in the Strategic Plan, and support any evaluation and impact assessment of the R&I Strategy.
- To keep up to date with developments in the area, particularly (though not exclusively) at national level.
- To work closely with all local R&I players including academia, private organizations, public research institutes, industry representatives, and government stakeholders.
- To prepare for and participate in relevant forums where matters of relevance to national R&I strategy development, implementation and evaluation are discussed.
- To keep abreast of international developments of relevance to the national R&I strategy.
- Other duties as assigned by his/her superiors.
