Report on Preliminary Proposals

Both in terms of numbers and quality of proposals, the call was a resounding success. A total of 58 proposals were submitted, ranging across all scientific fields requesting a total of Lm 2.9 million. A third of the proposals were coordinated by small and medium enterprises, with a total of 17 different SMEs participating in the call (47% participation). There were also 5 proposals coordinated by governmental entities (14% participation) with the remainder being from Academia (64% participation). The proposals were classified into five sectors namely: ICT (10 proposals), Environment (20 proposals), Manufacturing (6 proposals), Health and Biotech (14 proposals) and Other (8 proposals).

Out of 58 proposals, a total of 12 proposals have been short listed requesting a total budget of Lm 865,000.
