Admissibility and Eligibility Check

To be considered Admissible, a proposal must be:

- (a) Submitted in the Electronic Submission System before the deadline given in the call conditions
- (b) Readable, accessible and printable
- (c) Complete and inclusive of requested administrative data, proposal description, and any other docs
- (d) Include a draft plan for the exploitation and dissemination of the results at the second stage
- Limit for scientific doc Part II: Stage-1 'Pre-Proposal' 10 pages; Stage-2 'Full Proposal' 50 pages

To be considered Eligible, a proposal must:

- comply with the eligibility conditions set out in the Horizon 2020 RfP and any relevant derogations
- the coordinator of the proposal is a legal entity established in a PRIMA PS
- its content corresponds, wholly or in part, to the scope and objectives of the topic to which it is submitted
- it complies with the minimum consortium eligibility conditions...
- Section 2: additional criteria established by NFAs according to national regulations





Consortium eligibility requirements (<u>additional</u> <u>eligibility condition</u>)

at least four participating organizations from at least three different PRIMA Participating States.

1. Among these, one organization must be from an EU Member State or a third country associated with Horizon 2020 (not an MPC).

2. Additionally, you must have at least two organizations from Mediterranean Partner Countries (MPCs) that border the Mediterranean Sea. These MPCs include Algeria, Jordan, Israel, Tunisia, Morocco, Lebanon, Egypt, and Turkey.









Consortium eligibility requirements (<u>additional</u> eligibility condition)

MINIMUM CONSORTIUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT:

4 INDEPENDENT LEGAL ENTITIES FROM AT LEAST 3 PARTICIPATING STATES (PS)



- ONE PS EU
- TWO PS NON EU
- ONE PS EU OR PS NON EU

- EXAMPLES:
- MALTA-GREECE-MOROCCO-EGYPT = **ELIGIBLE**
- MALTA-GREECE-MOROCCO Entity 1- MOROCCO Entity 2 = **ELIGIBLE**
- MALTA-GREECE-FRANCE-MOROCCO = **NOT ELIGIBLE** (only 1 entity from the south)
- MALTA Entity 1-MALTA Entity 2- MOROCCO Entity 1- MOROCCO Entity 2
 - = NOT ELIGIBLE (only 2 countries)



Grant Agreement/ Consortium Agreement

Section 1

Grant Agreement: PRIMA MGA (multi-beneficiary), based on Horizon 2020 Consortium Agreement: Participants in projects resulting from this Call for Proposals will be required to conclude a consortium agreement prior to the conclusion of the PRIMA grant agreement.

Section 2

Grant Agreement: Each national funding body will sign a grant agreement (or any official documents acting as contract) with their national beneficiaries taking part in the selected project.

Consortium Agreement: A consortium agreement mentioning the distribution of the tasks among partners must be concluded. Some national funding bodies may require this document before signing the grant agreement.

Challenge

Small scale farming systems are the backbone of the Mediterranean farming system with an overwhelming contribution to the global food supply. However, many of the rural economies and smallholder farmers communities are struggling to sustain production, as low incomes, unsustainable and inefficient practices, lack of market connections and limited access to information are affecting their livelihood.

Fragmentation of the markets, inefficient farming practices, older age group of farmers, the disconnection between youth and their interest in agriculture are enhancing land abandonment and degradation, output quality and productivity, transparent and efficient access to markets (especially new markets based on e-commerce) and lack of valorisation of waste generated at farming level. Many organisational aspects made to support farmers, that was brought in the 20th Century, did not evolve to meet the current market demands, including the current models of cooperatives and associations that need uplifting. There is a significant need to have proper governance, less corruption, improved market intelligence, the introduction of innovative approaches in sustainable practices, market development, investment and




